Sharing their insights at the CBEC-REACT-ICC BASCAP workshop on countering counterfeiting with the help of customs, Dhruv Anand and Manish Biala talk about enforcement in the physical and digital worlds. Particularly, Dhruv elucidated the role and liability courts are acceding to intermediaries. Manish talked about the role and powers of customs officials in conducting after-market raids, and the need for greater verification of importers' identities.
